

STATE SHOW ARTWORK SUBMISSION GUIDELINES:

- Teacher must be a member of NAEA in order for student artwork to be accepted in the state show.
- All artwork must be matted and ready to hang.
- Please use white mats only!! Artworks can however have a small black edge inside such as if it were mounted or double matted. NO poster board used as mats!
- Artworks must have a secure backing behind the mat. Acceptable backing would be cardboard, mat board or foam board. NO posterboard! Backing board must be the SAME size as the mat. Do not make it smaller as the corners of the mat will get bent.
- Artworks must have a secure hanger on the back. Fishing line works best as it will not stretch. Do not use yarn. Hanging device should be placed directly in the center of your backing. The hanging line should not reach over the top of the artwork.
- All artwork must be completed in the classroom under the supervision of the art teacher.
- Art created in a private class is NOT eligible.
- All entries must be original and completed within the current school year.
- All pieces should be no smaller than 16x20 (mat size, not art size) and no larger than 36x40.
- No 3-D work.
- Paintings done on canvas board must be matted and have backing. Paintings done on full canvas must have edges painted and ready to hang.
- Student Release Forms must be submitted with artwork.
